Avira Free Android Security is available for download only via the *Google Play Store*. Existing users will get a notification directly from the *Google Play Store* to perform the update.

2. Bug fixes

• Updated GCM ID was constantly sent to web backend causing heavy loading

3. New features

- This version allows new users to create an account in Avira My Account
- Users, who have already registered to the *Avira Web Console* via a prior version of Avira Free Android Security, will have their accounts migrated to *Avira My Account*
- New users are required to enter a password upon registration
- Upon a successful registration, a user account will be created in Avira My Account

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
