

1. General Information

With Version 2.0, Avira is releasing for the first time an Antivirus for Android. The release of the Update Version 2.0 does not include any error fixes reported on Version 1.4 or earlier.

2. Target group

Avira Free Android Security Version 2.0 is an Android security app that sets the focus on mobile device anti-theft and virus protection. The product is intended for all users who would like to protect their device as well as their privacy on the mobile.

3. System requirements

3.1 The supported Smartphone manufacturers are:

- LG
- Samsung
- HTC
- Motorola
- Google Nexus
- Sony

3.2 Avira Free Android Security will officially support the Android version:

- 2.2 (Froyo)
- 2.3.x (Gingerbread)
- 4.0.x (Ice Cream Sandwich)
- 4.1.x (Jelly Bean)
- 4.2 (Jelly Bean)

However, any smartphone running at least Android 2.2 will be able to install and run the app. The Avira Free Android Security Version 2.0 supports as well several Tablets running on Android 4.0.x, 4.1.x and 4.2.

3.3 Devices with the following screen sizes are supported:

- Normal screens, low-extra high DPI¹
- Large screens, low-extra high DPI
- Extra-large screens, low-extra high DPI

5. Licensing and pricing

Avira Free Android Security 2.0 is a free product. No license is required.

6. Features

This is the first release of Avira Antivirus for Android. The core features include:

- On-demand scan of all installed non-system apps
- On-demand scan of all files and archives
- Auto-scan of non-system apps upon installation
- Auto-scan of non-system apps upon update
- Daily VDF & Engine auto-updates
- View detections of current scan
- View summary of previous scans
- Malware removal assistance
- Rollback VDF/Engine upon update failure
- Notification display for Auto Scan Status

7. Install / Uninstall

Avira Free Android Security is available for download only via the [Google play store](#).

To uninstall Avira Free Android Security, the user needs to make sure that the “device administration“ setting is deactivated. Avira Free Android Security can then be uninstalled via the Android application manager on the device, just like any other application.

Another way to uninstall Avira Free Android Security is to use the built-in Uninstallation Wizard, available in the “Help“ section of the app.

8. Update

Existing users will get an update notification directly from the *Google play store*, as is the case with other apps. The update will be performed once the user is tapping on **Update**.
