

1. General Information

With the release of Version 1.2, Avira will replace the push-messaging service used to trigger anti-theft commands remotely.

This update is important because Google has deprecated the existing service (C2DM) and replaced it with Google Cloud Messaging (GCM).

Additionally, the Version 1.2 also includes several bug fixes and improves the CPU/RAM usage.

The release will include the languages:

- German
- French
- Italian

- Push messaging mechanism changed. Google Cloud Messaging (GCM) replaces Cloud-2-Device-Messaging (C2DM)
- Improved handling if push messaging service registration service fails
- GUI changes to reduce RAM usage
- Improved 'device administrator' warning message
- Application Crash Report for Android service reenabled

3. Bug fixes

- Lock screen compatibility with Android 4.1.x improved
- Various blacklist bugs fixed
- SIM wipe bugs fixed
