## 1. General Information

Avira Free Android Security Version 3.0 will be released to Google Play on 3<sup>th</sup> December 2013.

This release has an entirely new look and feel where user experience will be significantly improved. In addition, the “Scream” feature is renamed to “Yell”.

\* The acronym DPI stands for the term „Dots Per Inch“. The dot density in the image display is a measure of the detailed rasterized visual display, and thus a quality aspect of the technical reproduction.

## 4. Supported Languages

The release of Version 3.0 will support the languages English, German, French and Italian.

## 5. New Features

This section lists the details of the new features:

- A fully redesigned User Interface and User Experience
- An optimized GUI design for 7-inch tablets
- The ability to add a profile name and a photo to the Avira Online Essentials account
- The main dashboard shows an overall status of the device (“Protected” or “Action Required”)
- The function “Scream” is now renamed as “Yell”
- The ability to test the anti-theft features “Yell” & “Locate” within the app
- The on-demand antivirus scan shows the actual amount (%) of progress completed during the scan
- The Blacklist feature has been simplified
- The Google Cloud Messaging synchronization mechanism runs fully in the background
- A new EULA has been implemented
- A new Application icon with Avira the (new) Logo has been added
- “Getting Started” is hidden in the GUI

## 5.1 Bug Fixes

Antivirus: If the VDF/Engine update process is interrupted, the VDF/engine continues to update whenever there is a change in the internet connection status to ACTIVE state

## 6. Install / Uninstall

Avira Free Android Security is available for download via the Google Play Store only. To uninstall Avira Free Android Security, the user needs to make sure that the 'device administration' setting is deactivated. Thereafter, Avira Free Android Security can be uninstalled via the Android application manager on the device, just like any other application. Another way to uninstall Avira Free Android Security is to use the built-in Uninstallation Wizard, available in the Help section of the app.

## 7. Update

Existing users will get an update notification directly from the Google play store, as is the case with other apps. The update will be performed once the user is tapping on **Update**.

Avira Free Android Security 3.0 is embedded with premium features. The premium features can be enabled when a user has purchased and activated the license in Avira Online Essentials.
