

1. General Information

This Service Pack is the first major update since the release of Version 2.0 and contains several new features.

2. Languages Support

The release of Version 2.0 SP1 will support English, German, French and Italian.

3. Supported Smartphone Manufacturers, Platforms Versions and System Requirements

Avira Free Android Security will officially support Android for versions 2.2, 2.3.x, 4.0.x, 4.1.x, 4.2 and 4.3. Smartphones running at least Android 2.2 will be able to install and run the app. Avira Free Android Security will support tablet running at least on Android version 4.0.

Devices with the following screen sizes are supported:

- Normal screens, low-extra high DPI
- Large screens , low-extra high DPI
- Extra-large screens, low-extra high DPI

4. New Features

- Android 4.3 support
- On-demand antivirus scanning continues in the background after exiting the app
- Notification shows number of apps scanned upon clean auto-scan completion
- A “Resolve all” button to delete or uninstall ALL detections
- An option to disable adware and Potentially Unwanted App (PUA) detections
- Antivirus BETA label removed
